An enteral feeding pump is a medical device used to deliver liquid nutrition directly into a patient's stomach or intestines through a feeding tube. It ensures that the nutrition is administered at a controlled rate to help maintain proper nutrition and hydration for individuals who cannot eat by mouth due to various medical conditions.

- This device is medically necessary.
- This device complies with TSA security screening requirements for external medical devices.
- This device is non-transmitting and does not contain Bluetooth or WiFi technology.
- This device has been tested to the aviation standards RTCA DO/160E parts 20 and 21 for radiated RF energy and susceptibility and IEC 60601-1 for safety.

TSA Security Screening for External Medical Devices

It is recommended that the Moog Infinity and Moog Infinity Orange Feeding pump be screened using:

- Metal Detector
- Personal Physical Screening

* Power off pump prior to passing it through the metal detector.

The Infinity and Infinity Orange feeding pumps use a rechargeable lithiumion battery, which complies with the FAA's policy on lithium batteries.
